The intent of the program and scheduled tours are designed to give all attendees an experience that will help them determine if aviation or the Air Force is a career choice.

Date/Location: The Teen Aviation Camp will be held at the United States Air Force Academy.

OCONUS participants may arrive in Colorado Springs, CO on Friday, 23 Jun 17, and depart on Friday, 30 Jun 17 (Alaska is **NOT** considered as **OCONUS** for this camp).

CONUS participants arrive in Colorado Springs, CO after 1200 on Saturday, 24 Jun 17, and depart before 1900 on Friday, 30 Jun 17.

Participants driving to the Academy should arrive anytime after 1200 and before 1600 on 24 Jun 17. Participants being picked up from the Academy should plan to depart anytime after 0800 on 30 Jun 17.

Cost: Lodging, meals, and activity fees are centrally funded beginning upon arrival to Teen Aviation Camp (OCONUS beginning with evening dinner on Friday, 23 Jun 17). **Air Fare or POV travel costs and spending money are the responsibility of the attendee.**

Eligible Applicants: The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- A dependent of an AF Active Duty or Active Duty Military assigned to/living on/working on AF led installation, AF Retired, AF Civilian Employees, Air National Guard (ANG), AF Reserve (AFR)
- Youth currently in their Freshman and Sophomore year
- Participants must have a valid picture ID (ex. military ID, driver's license, or school ID)
- Previous Teen Aviation Camp attendees may not apply

Application Criteria: Complete the Teen Aviation Camp Application Form (Atch 1)

Submission Instructions: Applications must be completed in their entirety to include a digital or wet ink signature. Applications should be labeled with first name and last name (ex. MichaelSmith.doc).
